It is directed to state that on consideration of the recommendations made by the Eastern Regional Committee in its 6th Meeting held on 11.5.93, the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) has accorded approval to the State Government of Orissa for introduction of following Diploma and Post-Diploma Courses in the existing polytechnics with an annual intake and duration shown against each as given below :

1.	U.S.M. Institute of Technology, Rayagada, Koraput.	Diploma in Electronics & Tele-Comm Engg.	3 years	20

3.	Jharsuguda Engg. School, Jharsuguda.	Post-Diploma in Computer Application	1-1/2 years	20
4.	S.K.D.A.V. Polytech. for Women, Rourkela.	Post-Diploma in Computer Application	1-1/2 years	20

The above approval is subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:

1. The infrastructural and other facilities should be provided as per AICTE norms and as recommended by the Expert Committee of the ERC.
2. The courses should be started only after one Head of the Department and two Lecturers in each course have been recruited and adequate infrastructural and other facilities are in position.
3. The curriculum of the courses wherever not available should be developed in consultation with the T.I.T.I., Calcutta.

4. The State Government should follow the recommendations made by the Expert Committee from time to time in each case and should also adhere to the provisions and the commitments given in the State's detailed Project Report submitted for the World Bank Assisted Technician Education Project.

5. The teaching staff should be recruited on an all India basis by open selection and as per procedure, qualifications, experience etc. as prescribed by the AICTE from time to time. State-based selections would be permissible for such posts for which the State Govt. prescribes "State-based Selection" as a general policy.
6. The admission should be made on merit and as per the guidelines issued by the AICTE from time to time and no contribution or donation of any kind shall be charged for admissions.
7. The tuition and other fees should be within the overall criteria prescribed by the AICTE.
8. The State Govt./ Polytechnic will not alter the approved intake in these courses under any circumstances without the prior approval of the AICTE.
9. The State Govt./ Polytechnic will neither close any of the existing approved courses nor start any new course without the prior approval of the AICTE.
10. The AICTE scales of pay should be granted to the teaching faculty.
11. The accounts of the Polytechnic shall be audited as per State Govt. Rules and be open for inspection by the AICTE or anybody authorised by it.
12. The reservations shall be provided for students and staff as per policy of the State Govt. applicable from time to time.
13. The AICTE shall not provide any maintenance grant or financial assistance of any kind.
14. The State Govt./ Polytechnic shall follow strictly any further conditions as may be laid down by the AICTE from time-to-time.

This approval is further subject to full compliance with the SOHPE as prescribed by the Supreme Court in its judgment dated 4.2.73 with regard to W.P.D. No.607 of 1972 in the case of Dr. K. Krishnan, J.P. and others etc. etc. vs. State of Andhra Pradesh and others etc. etc. and the related guidelines and criteria as may be issued by the AICTE or the Central Government from time to time.

In the event of non-compliance by the State Govt./ Polytechnic with the above conditions, the AICTE will be free to take measures for withdrawal of its approval without consideration of any related issues and that all liabilities due to withdrawal of approval would be that of the State Govt./ Polytechnic.

I am to request you to kindly take appropriate action to implement the decisions of the AICTE and communicate the progress made in this regard to the Eastern Regional Committee (ERC) of the AICTE under intimation to this office.
